Brief Overview of Key Responsibilities:

- To support the Olive Branch Counselling Service, volunteer counsellors, and clients, by providing group clinical Supervision and holding shared clinical responsibility for the client work undertaken by the counsellors.
- Supervise one group of up to 4 counsellors for 90 minutes once a fortnight.
- To respond to risk issues and safeguarding concerns and support supervisees to respond appropriately to risk and safeguarding issues, identifying any training or developmental needs.
- Working in-line with the Olive Branch policies and procedures as well as the BACP Ethical Framework.
- Work closely with the Head of Counselling and Clinical Lead, attending relevant meetings.
- Keep appropriate supervision notes and store them securely, in line with Data Protection laws and GDPR.
- Be a member of a professional body and maintain membership/registration whilst working as a Supervisor for the Olive Branch Counselling Service.

The Olive Branch has been providing affordable counselling to Winchester and the surrounding community for over 25 years, with a focus on individuals from low- or zero-income households. We have 36 volunteer counsellors, who are a mix of qualified counsellors and trainees on placement, providing long-term counselling to individuals (aged 18 and over) who self-refer to the service due to a wide range of mental health and wellbeing issues. We offer a supportive environment with the opportunity for varied and plentiful counselling experience.
